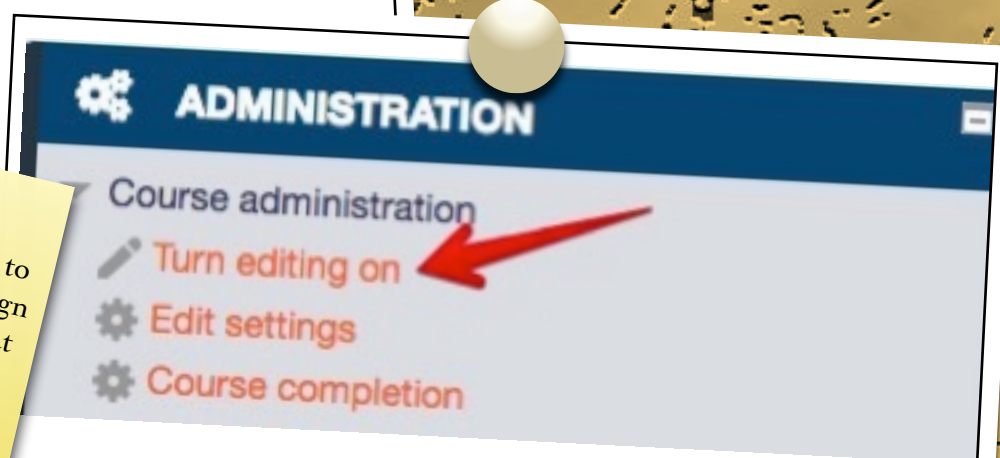

Let's Get Started!

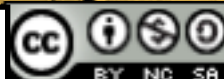




Once you've created the activity, duplicate it BEFORE any students fill it out. Duplicate it as many times as needed. With Editing on...

Adding a Random Glossary Entry block will feature students on the course homepage. These will change every time the page is refreshed.

Student Directions:

Our class will be creating a Class Roster. The Class Roster (called "Introductions") will highlight each member of the class. Each student will write a good paragraph introducing him/herself to the rest of the class. The introduction should be high quality writing. Please write one good, complete paragraph. Remember to vary your sentence length and use detailed descriptors. Please use these instructions to get started.

To create an entry:

- 1) Sign into our Moodle Course.
- 2) Click on the "Introductions" activity
- 3) Click on the Add a new entry
- 4) In the box after "**Concept**", add your name
- 5) In the box after "**Definition**", add your information about yourself. Write your introduction as a good paragraph. Do NOT just create a list. Be sure to include the following information:
 - One thing you look forward to this year.
 - Include at least one thing that you are good at.
 - At least one person that you admire. Explain why you admire this person.
- 6) Add a video of yourself saying "Hi" (by using Insert video)
OR
- 7) Add a recording of yourself saying "Hi"
